The jury that selected the three Cuban artists is made up of important critics, curators and museum directors from around the world.

#### Award

The Arte Laguna award is an international art competition that takes place every

year in Venice. The winner will receive a cash prize of 10,000 euros, as well as an exhibition at the Arsenale in Venice.

In addition, artists will have the opportunity to carry out creative residencies, work with companies, exhibit their works individually in galleries, and participate in international festivals.

The Arte Laguna Prize group exhibition is organized under the patronage of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Italian Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Tourism, and other institutions.

This is a great opportunity for Cuban art to be recognized and appreciated worldwide.

#### Construction

Artists can submit a portfolio of works made with technical and stylistic freedom in different techniques, such as painting, sculpture and installation, photographic art, video art and short films, performance art, digital art, digital graphics and cartoons, environment/land art, art urban/street art and artistic design.

The works may have been previously exhibited and the theme is free.

On the other hand, the works presented must meet the technical requirements specified for each category. The maximum size allowed is 175 cm per side.

The maximum duration of the video is 15 minutes. The video file must not exceed 500 MB. The exhibition space has no dark spaces.

In addition, the artists must provide the necessary material for the realization of the performance.

Finally, the finalists present the product or a full-scale prototype or a model of their project depending on the assembly chosen by the organization.
